



Discussion Prompts

The Discussion Prompts are provided to dig deeper into a sermon with the respective title mentioned on the right side of this guide (you can find the sermons at www.manheimbic.org/sermon).

Connect

Get to know each other. Connect, warm up to each other, fellowship. Just arrive after a long week of all kind of things. - Ask: Who are you personally?

Care

Carry each others burdens. Share life's challenges and practice Soul Care. Cry together. Support each other. Pray together. - Ask: How are you doing?

Challenge

Dive into God's word to learn from each others insight. Encourage & challenge each other to a godly life. - Ask: What is God teaching us today?

Study Guide:

We don't know exactly how Jonah said it, but when the Ninevites **heard** the message, they **believed**, and **turned** (Jh 3:1-10). In connection with the first three steps of Celebrate Recovery, Pastor Bryce pointed out that the key to **T.U.R.N.**ing your life around is fourfold:

T - Trust God!

Make a list of your hurts, hang-ups, and habits. Where have you been hurt? What hang-up bothers you? What habit can't you shake? Do you trust God to get you out of that mess?

U - Understand, God sees the bigger picture

Ask yourself: If God would fully step into this mess, what would it look like. Draw a picture, write a poem, create a piece of art, whatever feels right to you- create something that displays what the particularly situation would look like, if you would let God step into it.

R - Repent of your Sin

What is it actually that has caused you to be in this mess? Do you need to recognize a particular sin and ask God for forgiveness? Were you hurt by someone and you need to turn to God for healing? Are you stuck and you need God's guidance and direction? - In the fullest sense, all these are elements of the word *repentance*.

N - New Life In Jesus

Now, take a RED Sharpie. Take out the list that you made in step one. And in big letters write across this list "I have a new life in Christ."

I bet John 8:36 will be amongst your new favorite Bible verses. It says: "If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed!"

Clarify

Know what's to do next, with the studies text, within the group, and in general. Have a mission for the week. - Ask: How do we apply what we have learned?

Celebrate

Celebrate life's success and God's provision. Worship God's presence. Time to *brag* about God. - Ask: What has God done in our life that deserves praise?
