BIBLE PASSAGES

Matthew 22:37-40:

37And he said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. **38**This is the great and first commandment. **39**And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. **40**On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets.”

Matthew 28:18-19:

18And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **19**Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in^b the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

1 Peter 2:9-10:

9But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. **10**Once you were not a people, but now you are God’s people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

1 John 3:16:

16By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers.

4. How does 1 Peter 2:9-10 apply to our mission?
5. How are you, or will you participate in the mission this next year?

Clarify:
