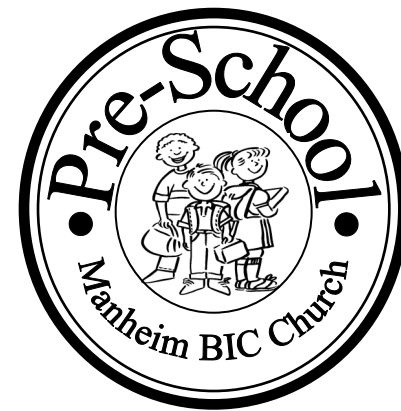

## Educational Objectives

- Cognitive Development: memory skills, puzzles, dramatic play, drawing, following classroom routines and enjoyment of books.
- Language Development: repetition of songs and finger plays, listen to simple stories, express wants, label common objects, and match colors.
- Self-concept: identify body parts, gender, identify family members and classmates, help put toys away and value personal property.
- Math Readiness: rote counting to three, identify a circle and a square, group objects by size, and match objects.
- Fine Motor Activities: finger strength and dexterity, eye-hand coordination, fill and dump containers, glue and pasting, painting, coloring.
- Gross Motor Activities: eye-arm coordination, clap to music, walk upstairs and downstairs unassisted, walk on tiptoe, jump and hop on one foot.
