BIBLE PASSAGES

John 12:12-15 **12**The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. **13**So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, crying out, “Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!” **14**And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written,**15**“Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey’s colt!”

John 14:1-6 **1**“Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God;^a believe also in me. **2**In my Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?^b **3**And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. **4**And you know the way to where I am going.”^c **5**Thomas said to him, “Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?” **6**Jesus said to him, “**I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.**

Matthew 21:7-9 **7**They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them. **8**Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. **9**And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, “Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!”

Connect:

Get to know each other. Connect, warm up to each other, fellowship.

Care:

Carry each other's burdens. Share life's challenges and practice Soul Care. Pray together.

Challenge:

Dive into God's Word. Use these discussion questions. Learn from each other's insight.

1) What big announcements have you made that were difficult? Ex: announcing your marriage to your parents, announcing a decision to family members, etc.

2) What are the main differences you see in your life with Christ vs outside of Christ?

3) How Does Jesus' determination to get to Jerusalem impact your thoughts about Holy Week?

4) Is the Statement that Jesus makes in John 14:6 comforting or challenging? Why?

5) What will be your response to Jesus this Easter? He is the Way. Have you RSVP'd?

Clarify:

Does anyone need clarity on something? Are there any big God questions you are wrestling with?

Celebrate:

Celebrate life's successes and God's provision. Worship God's presence. Time to brag about God.
