## BIBLE PASSAGES

*Mark 10:17-31*

*The Rich Young Man*

**17**And as he was setting out on his journey, a man ran up and knelt before him and asked him, “Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” **18**And Jesus said to him, “**Why do you call me good? No one is good except God alone.** **19**You know the commandments: ‘Do not murder, Do not commit adultery, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Do not defraud, Honor your father and mother.’” **20**And he said to him, “Teacher, all these I have kept from my youth.” **21**And Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, “**You lack one thing: go, sell all that you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me.**” **22**Disheartened by the saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

**23**And Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, “**How difficult it will be for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!**” **24**And the disciples were amazed at his words. But Jesus said to them again, “**Children, how difficult it is<sup>b</sup> to enter the kingdom of God! <sup>25</sup>It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God.**” **26**And they were exceedingly astonished, and said to him,<sup>c</sup> “Then who can be saved?” **27**Jesus looked at them and said, “**With man it is impossible, but not with God. For all things are possible with God.**” **28**Peter began to say to him, “See, we have left everything and followed you.” **29**Jesus said, “**Truly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for my sake and for the gospel, <sup>30</sup>who will not receive a hundredfold now in this time, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and in the age to come eternal life. <sup>31</sup>But many who are first will be last, and the last first.**”

## Matthew 6:20-22

**20**but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. **21**For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. **22**"The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is healthy, your whole body will be full of light,
