## Bible Passages

### ***Ephesians 4:1-6***

#### ***Unity in the Body of Christ***

**<sup>1</sup>I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, <sup>2</sup>with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, <sup>3</sup>eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. <sup>4</sup>There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— <sup>5</sup>one Lord, one faith, one baptism, <sup>6</sup>one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.**

#### ***Philippians 2:8***

**<sup>8</sup>And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.**

#### **Matthew 5:3-10**

**<sup>3</sup>"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**

**<sup>4</sup>"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.**

**<sup>5</sup>"Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.**

**<sup>6</sup>"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.**

**<sup>7</sup>"Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.**

**<sup>8</sup>"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.**

**<sup>9</sup>"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons<sup>a</sup> of God.**

**<sup>10</sup>"Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**

## **Group Discussion & Life Challenge**

### **Connect:**

Get to know each other. Connect, warm up to each other, fellowship.

### **Care:**

Carry each other's burdens. Share life's challenges and practice Soul Care. Pray together.

### **Challenge:**

Dive into God's Word. Use these discussion questions. Learn from each other's insight.

- 1) Share an experience from the past week that was awkward.
- 2) What do you think about when you hear the word WORTHY?
- 3) How do we examine our walk and if it is worthy, without getting into legalism or religious activity?
- 4) Describe a time in your life when you felt like you were very clear on your mission and your walk was strong? Maybe someone in the group could share a time when it was weak?
- 5) What will look different this week in your time with the Lord if you are walking worthy of the calling?

### **Clarify:**

Does anyone need clarity on something? Are there any big God questions you are wrestling with?

### **Celebrate:**

Celebrate life's successes and God's provision. Worship God's presence. Time to brag about God.
